- Coach Kim Voss - Recently arrived from America and appointed Coach of Alice Springs with open order to play with all Alice teams. Strong right hand bat, good third baseman.
- Pitchers Ron Duthie - Transferred to Federals from Port Adelaide in January. One of SA top pitchers. Strong right had bat. Recovering from knee operation which may slow him down.
- Darren Welch - Possibly the player with the most potential in Alice Springs. Rep in the Australian Under 19 team at recent World Youth Series in America. Strong third baseman. Steady right hand bat.
- Tony Prescott - Strong under-arm style pitcher. Well known to all Territory baseball supporters. Rep in three Claxton Shield teams, Hates training.
- Alan Winter - Alice Springs best pitcher last season. Claxton Shield rep in Perth last year. Only NT pitcher to go nine innings in Claxton Shield. Steady right hand bat.
- Bruce Pett - Good aggressive all round player. Kriewaldt Shield rep in Darwin last year. Pitched Saints to 8 grade premiership in 82/83. Steady right hand bat.
- Catchers Evan Gordon - Possibly the best defensive catcher in the NT. Claxton Shield rep 1982/83. Potential to be top batter. Useful right hand pitcher. As Australian Under 18 squad member visited USA in 1981.
- Peter Davies - Visited USA in 1983 as a member of the Australian Under 18 squad. Very critical of his own performance which is often mistaken for umpire hassling. Has potential to be a top NT catcher. Powerful right hand batter.
- Owen Gordon - NT rep in Junior sides. Faded from scene for a couple of years, now making a serious effort to gain a position in Claxton team. Has potential to be good utility player. Bats right hand.
- Infield Lawrie Hughes - Alice Springs first base in Darwin last year. Claxton Shield rep in 1983. Experienced Adelaide A grade player. Strong left hand bat.
- Bob Chapman - Alice Springs first base in Katherine and Tennant Creek 1978/79. Returned to Alice Springs this year to coach Panthers. Strong right hand bat.
- Brenton Levi - Joined Federals from Port Adelaide in January. Steady fielder. Has recovered from arm problems of last season. Plays second base. Steady right hand bat.
- Jim Chastain - Transferred to Panthers from Redsox this year. Batting has improved by playing with more competitive team. Alice Springs second base for several seasons. Steady right hand bat.
- Dale Walker - Dodgers coach for 1983/84. Fastest set of legs in town. Steady short stop but capable of playing anywhere. Good right hand bat.
- Clive Fiebig - Federals short stop of two seasons. Not the flashiest glove man in town but reliable. Good right hand pitcher and could be used as such this series. Steady right hand bat.
- Steve Bobos - Panthers short stop. Transferred to Alice from Southern Districts this year. Aggressive, quick thinking in-field already tipped as Golden Gloves award for this season. Good right hand bat.

- Infield** Jamie Anderson - Panthers infielder last season after Kriewaldt Shield rep for Katherine. This year will be seen mainly in outfield. Good base runner. Steady right hand bat.
- Outfield** Frank Beardsmore - Strong left hand bat. One of three Federals power left handers. Not the fastest outfielder but reliable hands. Came to Alice from Cairns last season. Another Prescott Kiwi.
- Rex Williams - Very quick base runner. Now playing outfield after many years in infield. Claxton Shield rep 1982. Steady right hand bat.
- Frank Rego - Transferred to Panthers from Southern Districts. Strong right hand bat. Good hands and strong throwing arm.
- Dudley Curren - Aces coach for 1983. Strong right hand bat. Played in Queensland last year.
- Shane Ashenden - Top left hand batter from Aces. Really showed his power last year and has potential to develop to NT rep with experience. Recent Riverside Shield Most Valuable Player.
- Doug Ransom - Mr Evergreen. Many years as Kriewaldt Shield rep for Alice Springs. Strong left hand batter. Most travelled "adopted" Yank in Alice Springs.
- Pitchers** Darren Burton - NT rep in Junior teams. First senior rep team. Strong left hand pitcher and steady outfielder. Good left hand bat.
- Leigh Hauber - Redsox coach for 1983/84. Premiership coach for Saints in B grade 1982/83. Power right hand bat. Transferred from West Torrens last year. Strong right hand pitcher but versatile enough to fill any position required.

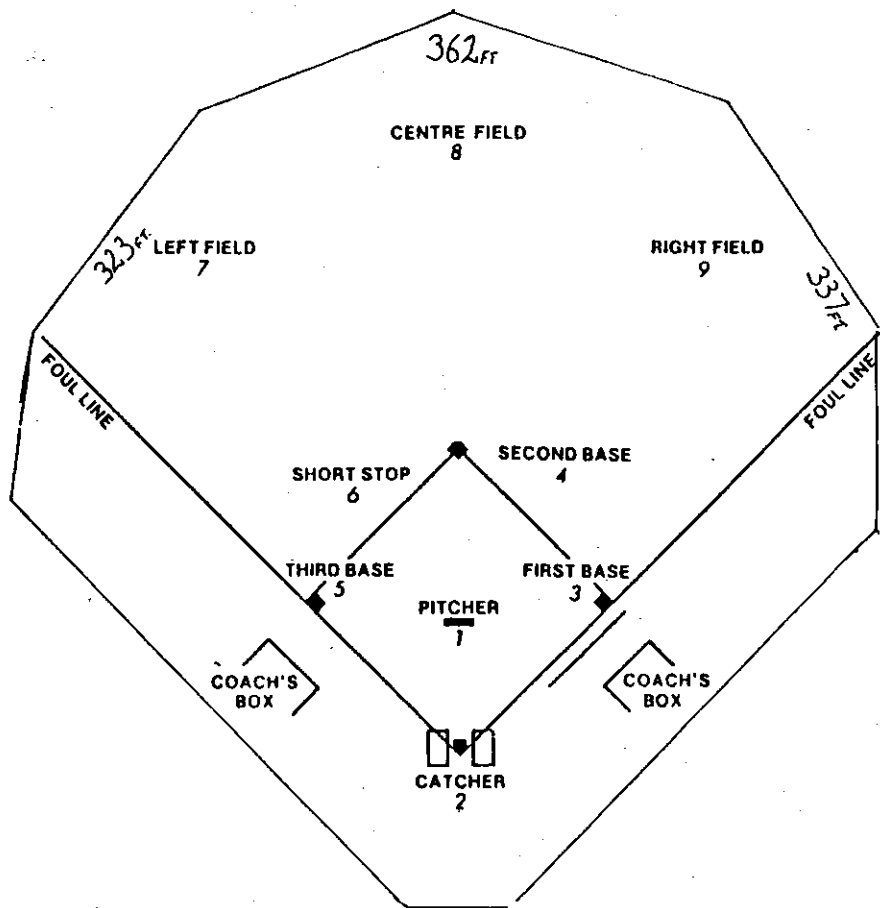
